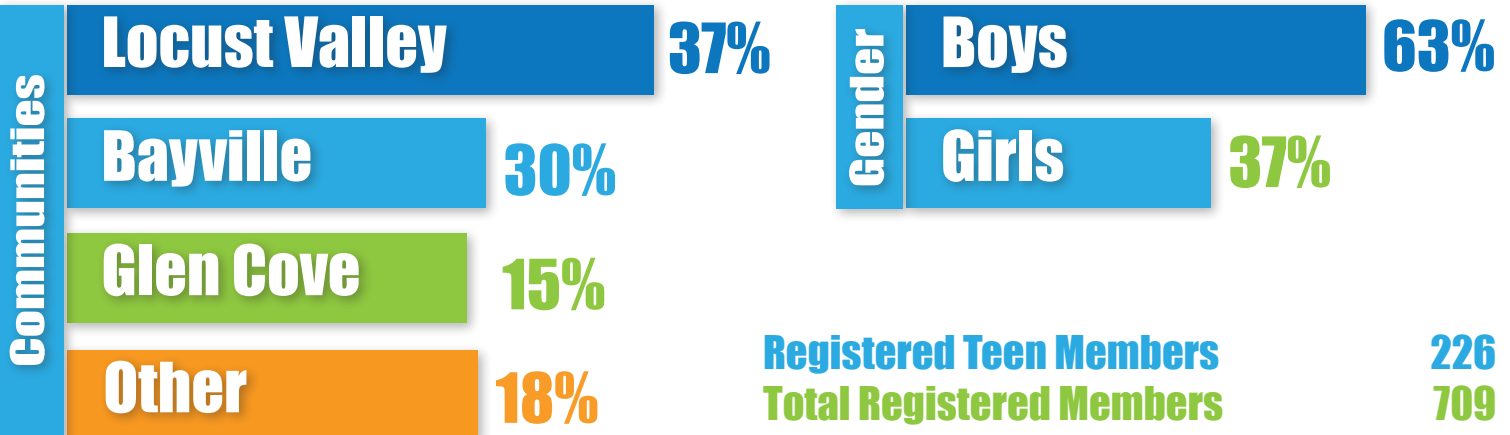

From The Executive Director



Dear Friends:

In 2020, Grenville Baker Boys & Girls Club celebrated its 70th Anniversary, a milestone that we had intended to mark with in-person celebrations with friends. Of course, 2020 had something quite different in store for all of us.

Our Club has always prided itself on its ability to adapt to the needs of the children in our community and the demands of the world we live in. What began in 1950 as a place to discourage kids from playing on the train tracks through athletics has evolved into a dynamic and full-service youth organization. These days, our Club provides 1,200 kids between the ages of 5 and 18 with afterschool child care, academic support, nutrition, programs in the arts and sciences, College Prep, community service, and a variety of sports and athletics opportunities.

Given our history of being able to proactively address the shifting priorities and circumstances of kids over the years, we were uniquely prepared to meet the unforeseen challenges of 2020. Indeed, when the pandemic took hold in March, 2020, our staff was able to pivot quickly to ensure that our kids stayed on track with their scholastic, emotional, and physical needs. Within days of the regional shutdown, our Club staff had devised creative and fun ways to stay meaningfully connected to our young members to help them feel supported and cope with the sea of uncertainty before them.

To this end, we posted motivational messages on social media, we "Zoomed," we texted, we called, we brought pizzas, and organized drive-by parades. We even personally delivered food to families facing food insecurity and partnered with other local organizations to establish a local food bank (NOSH) to help the community at large. At every turn, we let our kids and their families know that the Club was a place that they could count on. No matter what.

As we look back on one of the most difficult years in our collective history, I'm both delighted and humbled to say that Grenville Baker Boys & Girls Club demonstrated flexibility, creativity, and compassion.

Of course, our capacity to meet the moment was only thanks to the generosity of resources and spirit of friends and supporters, like you. We were also incredibly grateful to many of our foundation and corporate funders that provided emergency COVID funding. 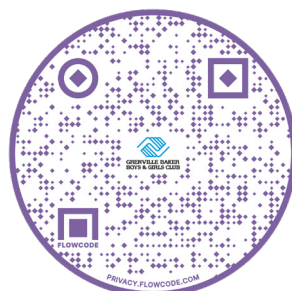
Spring

As schools and offices closed and we all found ourselves in "lockdown," our Club staff channeled their enthusiasm and creativity to ensure that no child felt isolated.

During the Spring, our K-5 members were greeted each morning with a motivational message by Ms. Michelle. For kids of all ages, we "Zoomed" to provide remote daily Homework Help and a Virtual Power Hour, as well as a series of virtual learning experiences. We also created a "GBBGC at Home YouTube Channel" (<https://bit.ly/3aH0EOg>) to keep kids engaged through our regular Spring programs, including SMART Girls, Passport to Manhood, Mad Scientists, Coding, and Photography.

We also provided emotional support and connectivity to kids and parents, alike. For our parents, we hosted chats in Spanish and English to address their questions and concerns. For our teens who experienced a great deal of stress and anxiety during this time, our staff stayed in close communication by telephone, text, and video chats. Plus, we didn't miss a beat with our Keystone Club, Money Matters, and College Prep programming.

The younger children also found ways to support one another. Nearly 40 children participated in a virtual art contest with the theme "What advice would you give to someone to be safe, happy and healthy during quarantine?"

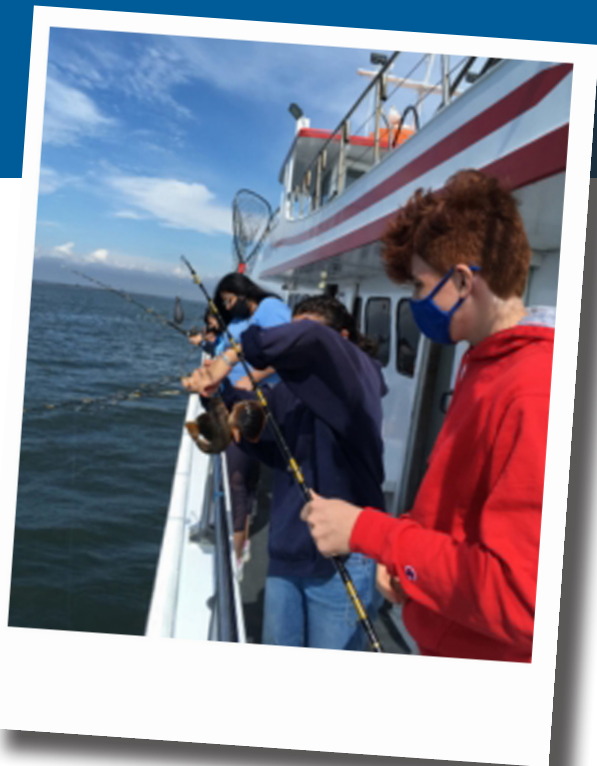


Summer

Prior to the pandemic, our Club had relocated our kids to three local community-based sites to accommodate our construction and renovation project taking place at our main Clubhouse. This temporary relocation turned out to work in our favor for the rest of 2020.

Indeed when weather turned warmer, we had ideal locations at which to offer a season of fun with built-in social distancing. For seven weeks over the summer, 45 children of essential workers enjoyed fun with friends and staff, explored the arts and sciences under the shade of a tree, and explored the natural wonders of our community.

Teens also enjoyed a change of routine. Our "City Club" was creatively transformed to the "Out of the City Club," and our young adults went on a number of outdoor adventures with Teen Program Director Stephanie Urio. These outings included a trip to Block Island; a boat and fishing for the first time; a cultural experience at the Nassau County Art Museum; and a variety of hikes along nature trails and the Long Island Sound.





Fall

By Autumn, remote and hybrid learning turned routine and kids were eager to see one another. Still operating out of our satellite locations, our staff continued to employ creativity to modify familiar activities that preserved time-honored traditions, while adhering to new health and safety standards. Our annual Spook Alley became a “Spooky Bus” where our teens handed out candy and goody bags to our costumed younger members, one at a time.

For many of our members, the pandemic provided a deeper perspective on the need that exists within our community. This point of view cast greater importance on our annual Thanksgiving Dinner. For health and safety reasons, we were unable to offer an open buffet, but that didn’t stop our generous donors, volunteers, and staff. In fact, this group was more determined than ever to help. The 2020 Thanksgiving Dinner was in the form of homemade “take out” for 200 families. In addition, generous donors put together 71 Thanksgiving baskets.



Winter

It wouldn't be holiday time without the Club's annual Operation Santa initiative! On the heels of a wonderful Thanksgiving effort, our Club pivoted once again to ensure that disadvantaged kids in our community had an extra special year-end holiday. Operation Santa, where volunteers fulfill children's wish lists, is one of our most cherished traditions in spreading love, joy, and warmth. Our volunteers were more excited than ever to help those in need at the end of a difficult year. In 2020, Club and community volunteers adopted 85 children and families!

At the same time, our Club carried on its own tradition of securing support for its Annual Fund. As you may know, the annual fund is our most important and flexible resource, as it allows us to meet the needs of our kids and families, no matter what comes our way. If 2020 taught us anything, it was that the world is unpredictable and flexibility is key to our ability to help others. Thanks to the generosity of donors, we were able to meet our annual fund goals.



Mission Fundraiser & Virtual Gala

At the outset of 2020, Grenville Baker Boys & Girls Club was busy laying plans for a year of celebrations to mark our 70th anniversary. We fully intended to gather with friends and donors to thank them for their support. While we were saddened to have to forgo these joyful moments together, we found an even deeper connection around the mission of the Club.

In June in lieu of our Dinner Dance, our Club hosted a Mission Fundraiser & Virtual Gala. For this "event," we asked our would-be diners and dancers to support the mission of the Club through donations in honor of our key program areas, including Homework Help, Afterschool Snacks, College Prep, Science Technology Engineering Arts and Math (STEAM) programs, Safety, and Membership. Our fundraising efforts also included an online auction and raffle. Finally and in keeping with tradition, we took time to recognize our Youth of the Year, Jimmy Mejia, and induct John Campbell, Gina and Anthony Core, and Bonnie and Arne Arnesen into our Hall of Fame for their dedicated service and support of the Club.

Through these efforts and thanks to the wonderful generosity of our members, supporters and friends, we raised critical funds needed to support our kids! So while there was no live party to speak of, we certainly had reason to celebrate.

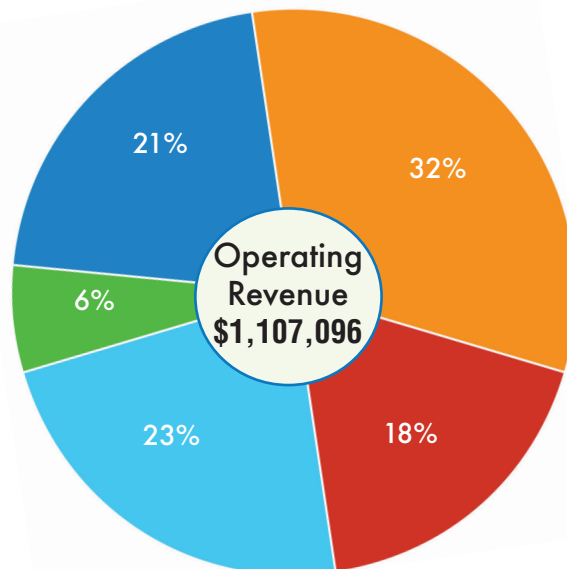

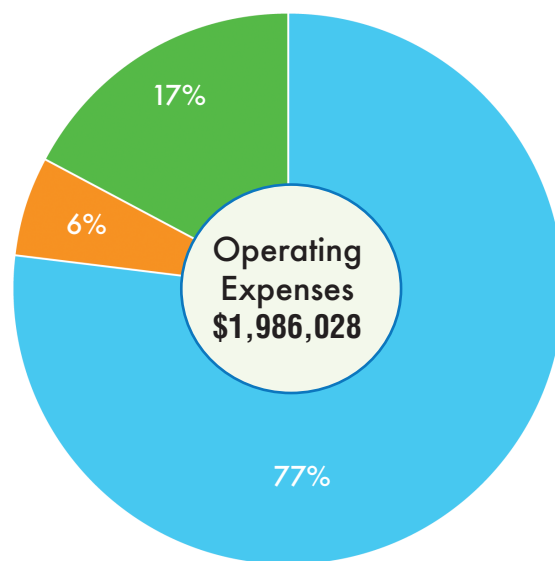
Total Operating Revenue



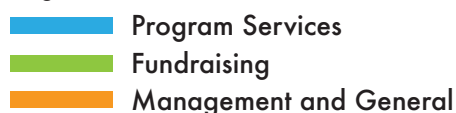
GBBGC derives its operating revenue from five main funding sources: Donations, Grants, Special Events, Program Fees and Royalty Income.
